Free primary and secondary education at Government Schools

6) Industrialization and Job Security

Creation of sustainable productive regional industries based on the spread of our natural resources – mainly rich agricultural land and minerals to provide jobs and socio-economic development.

7) Research and Development

Creation of platforms for unlimited human capital development, freedom, and progressive useful research aimed at industrial and social development

8) Diversity and Rights

Respect and acceptance of diverse cultures that promote peace, societal development, human and animal rights that do not prejudice on the rights of others or life are key to sustainable harmonious co-existence.

9) Laws and Security
